

Shops and Shopping Areas in Britain and in the USA

The first place you go shopping in London could be one of the large stores. This is the kind of shop that sells all kinds of things such as furniture, food, toys, etc. Two famous London department stores are Selfriges's and Harrods's.

Covent Garden is another area of shops and restaurants built in and around the old fruit and vegetable 1....made famous in B. Shaw's Pygmalion and the musical My Fair Lady. Covent Garden is also used for the Royal Opera House in the same area.

Department stores, supermarkets, chemists and other kinds of shops are often called 2....., which means they are part of a group of 3.....belonging to one company.

Shopping, however, is an art of its own and you have to learn slowly where to buy various things. In Britain as well as in America you can find different things at places you 4..... So if you are 5...., you can go to the chemist's (a drugstore in the USA). In large drugstores you may be able to get not only drugs, but 6...., candies, toys, braces, furniture.
